## How to receive Jesus in Holy Communion

Receiving Holy Communion is a very important action.


It shows that we fully belong to our Church family and that we are committed to living out the teachings of Jesus.


Before Mass, I do not eat or drink (except water) for one hour before receiving Holy Communion.

During Mass, I pay attention to everything that is going on. I join in the singing. I listen carefully to the readings. I say the responses.

When it is time, I join the communion procession and walk reverently.

As I approach to receive Holy Communion, I bow.





I hold out both hands, palms up, one hand under the other.

(If you are right handed, place right hand underneath. If left handed, place left hand underneath.)

The priest says: *The Body of Christ.* I say: AMEN


The priest places the host in the palm of my hand. I pick up the host and consume it.



Next, I approach the chalice. I bow.

The priest says: The Blood of Christ. I say: AMEN

I take the chalice firmly in both hands, and drink from it.



I return to my seat, and pray a prayer of thanksgiving.
