# **SACRAMENTAL PROGRAMME 2019**

Dear Parents,

8th November 2018

The sacraments of **First Reconciliation**, **Confirmation**, and **First Holy Communion** are important and wonderful steps on your children's faith journey and their welcome into the Church community.

This letter sets out the dates involved in the celebration of these sacraments in 2019. Please note the dates in your diaries, especially the due date for enrolment, and please be aware that more detailed information regarding each sacrament will appear in the parish bulletin, in a letter to our local schools and on our website a week or so before enrolment begins.

The preparation for each of these sacraments involves enrolment and an initial parent meeting which <u>must</u> be attended by at least one parent for enrolment to be confirmed. **In 2019 we will continue our new format for our Sacramental Programmes which we hope makes them more engaging and spiritually fruitful occasions for both parents and children.** One benefit for busy families is that we have reduced the number of weekends on which sessions need to be attended. The trade-off is that some sessions are longer but they will include some fun breaks and enrichment activities. Thus, we will still devote the same amount of time to helping you and your children prepare for these great occasions of faith, though the number of days affected will be reduced.

The celebrations of these sacraments are important events in the life of your family and also of the wider parish community into which the children are being welcomed. On the attached timetable you will see that in addition to the meetings there are also a number of special celebrations **at Sunday Masses** in the weeks prior to the celebration of each sacrament – **attendance** at these celebrations is an **essential** part of your participation in the preparation programme. There is also a short afternoon gathering for a special Mass for both children and parents towards the end of the preparation programme for First Holy Communion – attendance at this Mass by the children and at least one parent is an absolutely essential part of the First Holy Communion preparation programme as we will use this opportunity to deepen the children's understanding of the Mass and its various parts.

Children must be **baptised** before enrolling in the sacramental programme. If your child was baptised in any parish other than Lindfield-Killara, a copy of their baptism certificate needs to accompany the enrolment form. Unfortunately we cannot accept enrolments without this documentation.

Please note that to **celebrate First Holy Communion** the children need to have **celebrated Confirmation** <u>and</u> First **Reconciliation**. The minimum age for a child beginning the sacramental programme is 7 years – though as parents you know your child best and may wish to wait a little longer if you feel that they are not yet ready. We do hope that you will understand that the parish needs to make a charge for each sacramental programme to cover the costs of providing this time of preparation. This amount has been calculated to cover the cost of employing our paid Sacramental Coordinators and the various costs in running the programmes, providing materials etc. It is not intended to be a fundraising source – merely a charge to enable us as a parish to give you the best support and experience for your children during their time of preparing for the sacraments.

I look forward to joining you for the celebration of these sacraments with your children in 2019. These celebrations are beautiful moments of grace when, as a Church, we share the love of God made visible in Christ Jesus our Lord with these precious young members of the Church.

### When to enrol your child:

Our parish encourages families to enrol for the Sacraments as follows:

- Yr 2 and older Confirmation
- Yr 3 and older Reconciliation
- Yr 3 and older Holy Communion (must have celebrated Confirmation & Reconciliation)

PLEASE NOTE ALL THESE DATES IN YOUR DIARY NOW AS BEING ON HOLIDAY DURING THE TIMES OF OUR PREPARATION PROGRAMMES MEANS YOU CAN'T COMPLETE THE PROGRAMME. - Please understand that it will not be possible for your child to celebrate the particular sacrament unless they have <u>attended</u> all preparation days and you have attended the parent meeting.

### The information that follows should help you to complete the enrolment process:

In our diocese we follow the traditional order of the sacraments, with First Holy Communion being the final of the above three sacraments to be celebrated. The celebration of First Reconciliation and Confirmation therefore precede First Communion. A fuller explanation of this practice is found on the parish website under 'Sacraments'  $\rightarrow$  'Children's Sacraments', where you can download the booklet 'The Sacraments of Initiation'.

### How to enrol:

**Enrolments** and **Payments** are done online through **Trybooking.com**. You will receive a letter through your local school or at the back of the church a week before the enrolment period (the details will also be on the website under 'Sacraments'  $\rightarrow$  'Children's Sacraments' and will be in the Parish bulletin).

In 2019 the cost for each sacramental preparation programme will be \$73 per family (not per child) + 30c Trybooking fee. If you have *difficulty paying* this fee, please contact Fr Colin on <u>colin@lindfieldkillara.org.au</u> or (02) 9416-7195. All children are very welcome and if you have any concerns if your *child has difficulties*, please contact us and we will make a plan together. We do hope that you will understand that the parish needs to make a charge for each sacramental programme to cover the costs of providing this time of preparation. This amount has been calculated to cover the cost of employing our paid Sacramental Coordinators and the various costs in running the programmes, providing materials etc. It is not intended to be a fundraising source – merely a charge to enable us as a parish to give you the best support and experience for your children during their time of preparing for the sacraments.

**Baptism certificates:** A copy of your child's baptism certificate must be **emailed to maia@lindfieldkillara.org.au** during enrolment or brought to the Parent Meeting. If your child was baptised in the Lindfield-Killara Parish please still email Maia to let her know so we know to look you up in our system.

**Confirmation Name and sponsors:** If you are **enrolling** for **CONFIRMATION**, please think of and research a Confirmation Name with your child, before the enrolment dates, as you will need this to enrol online. Our diocese asks that the Confirmation name be a Canonised Saint's name since your child is choosing that saint as a model to follow in their own Christian life. Your child may also choose to be confirmed with their original Baptism Name (if it is a Saint's name). Saints names that will be accepted are found on the Parish website under 'Sacraments'  $\rightarrow$  'Children's Sacraments'  $\rightarrow$  at the bottom of the page see the link under - 'Choosing the name of a Saint for Confirmation'. Your child's sponsor needs to be over 16 years old and fully initiated into Catholic Church (i.e. has received Holy Communion). A parent can stand in for an absent sponsor but cannot be the sponsor.

Our preparation programmes are a combined effort of our whole parish made up of our two communities centred on our churches at Killara and Lindfield. Due to logistics, all **Group Preparation Sessions** will be held at **Lindfield** and the groups will be allocated rooms at the church and classrooms in the school. We will all meet inside the Lindfield church for the parent meeting and Sessions 1. The children's books will then be labelled with the rooms where you are allocated for sessions 2-4.

You can form your own group/ part of a group of 6 candidates or we will place you in a group after you enrol.

To enrol as a group, first select a parent facilitator and then all enrol your child individually, using this facilitator's name while enrolling and this will link your group.

#### Other information:

For your convenience, the **Piety Shop for Sacramental gifts** is located in the parish office (1<sup>st</sup> floor, above the Lindfield church). We stock gifts including Bibles, religious books, rosary beads, figurines, prayer cards and much more.
