

FINANCE COMMITTEE REPORT YEAR ENDED 30TH JUNE 2018

The Parish Finance Committee reports as follows on the financial position and performance of the Parish for the year ended 30th June 2018.

The cash position of the Church A/c has deteriorated slightly from approximately \$100,000 over the year to \$90,000.

The revenue and expenses for the year recorded a deficit of \$6,300, which by comparison to a deficit of \$10,000 for the previous year has improved. Operating income was down by \$10,000 due to some falls in the second loose collection. Operating expenses were \$14,000 less than the previous year due to lower repairs and maintenance costs, and almost \$6000 in motor vehicle expenses. As you may be aware, we no longer have our parish bus, which would have required substantial repairs for it to continue.

Once again the 2018 Fete proved to be a significant booster to the Parish's financial position, which raised over \$25,000. Initially it was uncertain if the Fete would go ahead, however this proves to be a valuable event for our Parish Community both in spirit and the viability of our Parish. Truly an outstanding effort for all those involved.

A summary of these figures appears in the table which also includes a detailed Statement of Income and Expenditure for the financial year.

Thank you to all Parishioners who are currently contributing via the planned giving scheme. With a number of repairs and maintenance issues to be attended to this financial year such as our roof and repairs to the Church pews, and a fall in income particularly from planned giving, we seek your continued support.

We urge those not currently in the planned giving scheme to join it either via the Envelope system or preferably by the Credit Card option. For those already using planned giving and you haven't already done so, please review your commitment for this financial year. Also those using the credit card option please update the expiry date with the Pastoral Office if you have had a new credit card issued recently.
