

> This weekend we remember the six Good Samaritan sisters who arrived at Kure, Japan on 15 November 1948. Kure is a harbour very close to Hiroshima. The sisters then went by train to Nagasaki. Atomic bombs had been dropped over both Hiroshima and Nagasaki three years earlier in August 1945, during the final stage of World War II.

This year is the 70th anniversary of their mission in Japan.

Today there are Japanese Good Samaritan sisters on mission in the Philippines.

You say that I am a king.
