Infant Baptism Program 2026

The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated in the Cathedral outside of Mass. Baptism is the first Sacrament in the Order of Christian Initiation (Confirmation and Eucharist being the other two Sacraments). It is the Parish Community who welcomes your child for Baptism and so there is a responsibility of the Parish and Parents to see that the gift of Eternal Life is nourished.



In our Parish, the Sacrament of Baptism for children 4 years and younger is celebrated in the following way:

- A 40-60-minute talk to speak about the Church's expectations concerning Baptism. **Meet in the Cathedral Courtyard.**
- The Baptism of your child will take place on a Saturday/Sunday 12noon outside of Mass. **Please bring your own Baptism Candle.**



Should parents present a child for Baptism who is **older than 4 years of age**, the parents will be introduced to the Diocesan Program for Baptism of Older Children.

Please visit the Cathedral Parish Office at your earliest convenience to return the completed form in this brochure along with a copy of your child's Birth Certificate, and to **collect a Baptism workbook to read before the Parent Talk**.

If you are **not** parishioners of Hornsby Cathedral Parish, **please contact your Parish Priest and obtain a letter of permission** for the baptism to take place. The letter of permission is also to be submitted to the Cathedral Parish Office.

Godparents are to be over sixteen, fully initiated (received the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist) and practicing their faith so as to be a good support for parents and a good role model for the child.
