

Members of the XVI General Ordinary assembly will be gathering in Rome in just a few days' time, along with our Broken Bay representatives, Bishop Anthony Randazzo, and Diocesan Chancellor, Mrs Kelly Paget.



The Vatican is asking all baptised people to participate in October's assembly of the Synod of Bishops with their pray-

"The Synod is first and foremost an event of prayer, and listening does not solely involve the members of the synodal assembly, but every baptised person, every particular Church. Indeed, all are called in this moment to join ourselves to the communion of prayer and in the insistent invocation of the Holy Spirit so it may guide us in the discernment of what the Lord asks today of his Church."

"The voices gathered from the People of God, in the Diocese of Broken Bay will be heard at the upcoming Synod through the varied and many consultation processes conducted over the past few years.
