Chrism Mass 2024

The Chrism Mass will be celebrated at 7.30pm on Tuesday 26 March at Our Lady of the Rosary Cathedral, Waitara. Priests of the Diocese of Broken Bay gather for this celebration with Bishop Anthony Randazzo to renew their priestly commitments. During Mass, the Oils of Catechumens and the Sick are blessed, and the Chrism is consecrated and brought back to each parish for use in various Sacramental liturgies throughout the year. All parishioners are warmly invited to attend this sacred occasion in the life of our Diocese.

ePetition to Restore Funding for Palliative Care

An online petition to restore \$150 million of allocated funding slashed from palliative and end of life care from the State budget will remain open until April. The petition is designed to indicate to the government how strongly citizens feel about the need to maintain support and true palliative care for those facing death. National Week of Prayer for Evangelisation


