A Recent Note from Bishop Anthony re the refrain from sharing the Chalice during Mass:

The teaching of the Catholic Church on the reception of the holy Eucharist is carefully explained in the Catechism of the Catholic Church:

CCC 1390 Since Christ is sacramentally present under each of the species, communion under the species of bread alone makes it possible to receive all the fruit of Eucharistic grace. For pastoral reasons this manner of receiving communion has been legitimately established as the most common form in the Latin rite. But "the sign of communion is more complete when given under both kinds, since in that form the sign of the Eucharistic meal appears more clearly." This is the usual form of receiving communion in the Eastern rites.

We are also aware that the manner for receiving is a pastoral one. Likewise, the limiting of the communion chalice to the people in the time of the COVID pandemic was for pastoral reasons.

Some COVID health statistics may also be of assistance: as of 8 June 2023, 1516 people in NSW are in hospital with COVID; 48 people are in ICU; and 81 people lost their lives from COVID in the past seven days, it is clear that we are not through the COVID pandemic yet, rather we are learning to live in a COVID effected environment. The Bishops of NSW have prayed about and discussed this situation, and we have taken the decision to delay the common use of the communion chalice, for pastoral reasons. In the meantime, as a community of believers, we can take heart in the joy of knowing and believing that to receive communion is to receive Christ himself who has offered himself for us. And as the Catechism reminds us "Since Christ is sacramentally present under each of the species, communion under the species of bread alone makes it possible to receive all the fruit of Eucharistic grace." It is important for us to remember that while the communion chal-

ice is currently limited, the fullness of communion in Christ's Body and Blood is enjoyed in the consecrated species of bread alone.

The bishops of NSW are keeping vigilant on this most important issue, so please be assured that when possible, the common communion chalice will be restored.
