This week the Vatican's released the Declaration *Dignitas Infinita* or Infinite Dignity.

The Declaration states that “every human person possesses an infinite dignity, inalienably grounded in his or her very being – “which prevails in and beyond every circumstance, state, or situation the person may ever encounter”. There are passages and quotes not only from Pope Francis, but also his predecessors Popes John Paul II and Benedict XVI.
