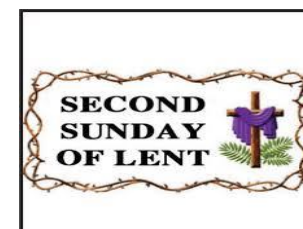

(Matt 26:40). Jesus invites us to spend time in adoration on the Wednesdays of Lent before the 7pm Mass. Reconciliation may be offered subject to the availability of a priest. Please add your name to the lists at the Church doors if you can accept Christ's invitation. We seek a minimum of two people in each 15 minute period between 6pm and 7pm.

Lenten Fridays – For all Fridays during Lent from 7.00pm until

8.00pm we will have Stations of the Cross, based on Scriptural verses. During this hour the Sacrament of Reconciliation will be available. Refer to the notice board for further details.

Lenten Reflection Group – Chapel OLR Church

Every Tuesday of Lent ; 7 pm to 8:30pm ; The group will follow the “Discerning the Way of Jesus” program that our Diocese has suggested. Each session will dedicate time to go through the readings of each Sunday of Lent following a Lectio Divina process, meditation, prayer and reflection. The purpose of this time of prayer is to prepare for the Easter mystery.

Ecumenical Lenten Group – Holy Family Anglican Church, Wyoming –

Monday 7.30pm, Tuesday 2.00pm, Thursday 1.00pm and Thursday 7.30pm. At times we may struggle to pray. Jesus' disciples asked Him to teach us how to pray and Jesus taught them the Lord's Prayer. During the period of Lent we will cover six areas of prayer using the Lord's Prayer – Adoration, Petition, Intercession, Perseverance, Learning to listen and Warfare.
