Jubilee Pilgrimages

You are invited to participate in one or more of the following Pilgrimages to Diocesan Jubilee sites. Firstly, at no cost (make your own way there or "car pool")

Shrine of Hope for Families – East Gosford: Saturday 31 May - 8.30am Adoration, 9am Mass, Devotion to St John Paul II thereafter.

<u>Shrine of Hope for Young People – Chatswood:</u> leaving 9.30am Saturday 28 June, travel to Chatswood for Mass and Devotion to Blessed Carlo Acutis, lunch then return journey

Shrine of Hope for Priests & Vocations - Manly: leaving 9.30am Saturday 26 July, travel to Manly for Mass and Devotion to St John Vianney, lunch then return journey

Diocesan Cathedral - Waitara: leaving 9.30am Saturday 30 August, travel to Waitara for Mass, Adoration thereafter, lunch and return journey

Each pilgrimage provides the opportunity to secure a Plenary Indulgence and a Pilgrim's Passport stamp. (limited to 57 people). Each time we travel, the cost will be \$30 fee for the transport and light lunch (sandwich). As we will have 3 trips, please be aware that the fee applies each time.
