After Mass we have the Pentecost bonfire, with music to grace the occasion.

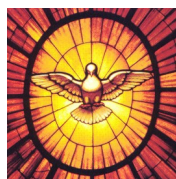
Please bring a chair to sit on,

Secular Franciscans on the Central Coast

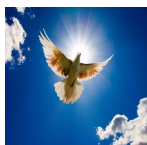
