## Cardinal Pell to be farewelled and buried in Sydney

A Pontifical Requiem Mass for Cardinal George Pell will be held at St Mary's Cathedral in Sydney on Thursday 2 February at 11am, following his death in Rome on 10 January. Archbishop Anthony Fisher OP will be the Principal Celebrant at the Mass, which will be open to all and also livestreamed on the St Mary's Cathedral You Tube Channel, prior to the Cardinal's burial in a private ceremony in the cathedral crypt.

Cardinal Pell will lie in state at St Mary's Cathedral from 9.30am on Wednesday 1 February.
