Reintroduction of Holy Communion Under Both Species

This weekend our parish—along with all parishes in the Broken Bay Diocese—will reintroduce Holy Communion under both species: the Body and the Blood of Christ.

Receiving from the chalice is optional. Those who prefer to receive only the host still receive the whole Christ.

There will now be four Communion lines near the sanctuary:

- Two lines in the centre aisle for the Body of Christ
- Two lines on either side for the chalice

If receiving from the chalice, please approach the minister after receiving the host.

Holy Communion will no longer be distributed in the middle of the nave.

Please take home one of the information sheets prepared by the Diocese about this matter.

The November Appeal is on now! PWBB helps fund hospital chaplaincy, CatholicCare assistance, faith education for children in public schools.


