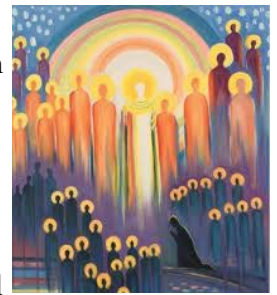


Third collection for World Mission Day
