We pray for those who have suffered harm from members of the Church; may they find within the Church herself a concrete response to their pain and suffering.






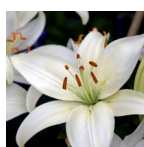


## Seeking volunteers for the Easter celebrations
