On 30th September we celebrate the Founder's Day of the Missionaries of St. Francis de Sales (MSFS).

Fr. Peter Marie Mermier (1790–1862)

(Servant of God)

Born during the French Revolution, Fr. Mermier experienced its turmoil and later became a priest in the Archdiocese of Chambéry, France. In 1838, he founded the MSFS and the Sisters of the Holy Cross of Chavanod (SCC). His famous call, **"I want missions!"**, led to parish missions, catechesis, and the sending of missionaries to Vizag, India, in 1845.

Today, members of both congregations serve across the world, especially in India and Africa, carrying forward his vision.

- M**issionary par excellence
- E**ducationist of the time
- R**eligious to the core
- M**issions Preacher
- I**nborn Catecheist
- E**nthusiastic visionary
- R**eaders of signs of time.
