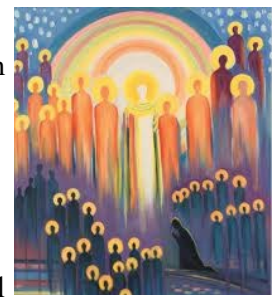
Parish family challenge: Make your own Advent wreath using recycled materials.
