## Canonization of Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati and Blessed Carlo Acutis

On Sunday 7 September, Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati and Blessed Carlo Acutis will be canonized together.

Though they lived in different times—Pier Giorgio in the 20th century and Carlo becoming the first saint of the 21st century—both embraced the call to holiness at a young age. Pier Giorgio devoted his youth to serving the poor and less fortunate through charitable works, while Carlo nurtured a deep love for the Eucharist, creating a website to share Eucharistic miracles with the world.

To mark this historic moment, Bishop Anthony Randazzo will celebrate Mass on Sunday at 5:30pm at Our Lady of Dolours Church, Chatswood. During the Mass, he will formally install the relic of Blessed Pier Giorgio and bless the church's new Eucharistic Chapel, where a relic of Blessed Carlo is already enshrined.
