Season of Creation 1 September – 4 October 2022

1 September is the World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation, established by Pope Francis in 2015. This day begins the 'Season of Creation' which runs until 4 October, the Feast of St Francis, and is an ecumenical season calling all Christians around the world to pray and take action for our common home. The theme for 2022 is "Listen to the Voice of Creation." In his message for World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation, Pope Francis says, "If we learn how to listen, we can hear in the voice of creation a kind of dissonance. On the one hand, we can hear a sweet song in praise of our beloved Creator; on the other, an anguished plea, lamenting our mistreatment of this our common home." *Prayer:*

Praise to you, Lord, God of all creation. For through your goodness, you endowed creation with your divine goodness, which in turn reveals and speaks of your power and love. Direct our thoughts to know you more through your diverse creation. Amen.
