God is on the Journey, Too: Garratt Lenten Program Year A

A timely Lenten resource that speaks to the concerns – and weariness – of Australians who have spent several years dealing with the Covid pandemic. The author reflects on how 'At every stage of the journey of faith, there is something to learn, invitations for us to grow, and opportunities for our relationships with God and others to be strengthened, healed, and renewed.'

This Cup We Bless: A tea or coffee break for every day during Lent

This book is an invitation to drink deep, to find God in the ordinary moments of every day during Lent.

From Ashes to Hope (Diocese of Brisbane)

Daily reflections that invite the reader to contemplate a verse from the Scripture reading of the day. This reflection will be followed by a quote from Pope Francis and a simple prayer.

Triumph (Diocese of Wollongong)

Daily reflections from Ash Wednesday to Easter Sunday for personal reflection in addition to longer-form Sunday Scripture reflections, readings, responsorial psalms, prayers, and reflection questions. The book also includes beautiful artwork from the Masters with accompanying artwork reflections.
