The Sacrament of Reconciliation is now also available on Fridays from 8:15–9:00 AM, in addition to existing times.


Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Sunday 6 July 2025

Sacramental Program 2025 – Parent Information Session

An information session for parents will be held on **Tuesday**, **5 August**, from 7:00–8:00 PM.

This program is for children in Year 3 or above preparing for the Sacraments of Confirmation, Reconciliation, and First Communion. The dates for this year's program are:

- Confirmation: Saturday 23 August 2025
- Reconciliation: Friday 5 September 2025
- First Communion: Saturday 20 September.

Parent attendance to this session is mandatory. Candidates (children) do not need to attend.

The <u>schedule for preparation classes</u> is available on our website and on the parish notice board. When enrolling, you'll be asked to:

- Select your preferred session time for classes
- Provide your child's Baptism date and place
- Attach a copy of the Baptism certificate (if not baptized at Wyoming Parish)
- Pay the \$40 enrolment fee.
