CatholicCare will be offering an Introduction to Pastoral Care Course (IPCC)

Volunteer Catholic Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion visit hospitals throughout the Diocese of Broken Bay providing comfort and care to Catholic patients. Our Diocese and NSW Health require that 40 hours of training is completed to perform this important role. The course (IPCC) meets this requirement, is **FREE** and is open to those who already volunteer in a hospital context, or in local health and aged care facilities, and to those who might be deciding if they are suited to this ministry.

The course will be offered on five consecutive Wednesdays: **July 2,9,16,23 and 30 between 9:00am and 3:00 pm** at CatholicCare Family Centre (10/10 Pioneer Avenue, Tuggerah).
