An Easter message

My dear Parishioners, Visitors and Friends,

The Easter story begins very early in the morning of the first day of the week while it is *still dark*. Mary of Magdala was first to go to the tomb, before dawn when it was still dark, and discovered it empty.

Jesus was missing, so her lament to the disciples was: They've taken my Lord from the grave and we don't know where they have put him.

Her soul searching could express the experience that we all go through: What have they done with the Risen Jesus? When Mary does see Jesus, she's so blinded by grief and tears that she does not recognize him; she thinks he's the gardener.

Jesus just asks her a question: Woman, why are you weeping? Who are you looking for?

When Mary doesn't recognize Jesus, he calls her by her name, with the same tenderness in his voice as when they were walking through Galilee:

Mary! She turns around quickly: Rabbuni! Master! Jesus calls us by our own name, are we prepared to listen to the invitation? When we do listen our faith grows, and that is the love of Jesus initiated to us through our own Baptism, Scripture, Tradition, and above all, the most precious gift in the Eucharist, a shared gift of faith, all that leads us to meet the Risen One.

The resurrection is deeply mysterious and is still a living journey. Even today, it reminds us that the darkness of evil and hatred will never have the last say. For the Resurrection of Jesus proclaims the ultimate triumph of light over darkness and goodness over evil, both in us and in our world.

Let us all be an Easter people. Where Alleluia is our song of Joy...


