## Upcoming Events

Dear friends

In 2020 a Plenary Council will be held by the Church in Australia. The highest form of gathering in our Church is an Ecumenical Council, such as the Vatican II Council of 1962-1965. An Ecumenical Council which gathers every bishop in the world reflects on faith and morals, whereas a Plenary Council determines legislation for a particular region. It is governed by its own norms, but is a remarkable opportunity for the Church in a particular context to determine the practice by which it might journey into the future. The Australian Bishops have sought to underscore this event by seeking to engage us all with the question, "What is God asking of us at this moment.?" Every diocese, and many parishes around the country have been entering into the first phase of addressing this question through a process of listening. Next year, the process will develop into a phase of discerning, and then of proposing. Our own Parish has been an active participant in the journey and last Thursday the third and final 'listening session' was held. Our deep gratitude to Tom Waugh, Gemma McDermott, Ken Laing, Annette Stuart-Robertson and Patrick Kirkwood who nominated as our local animators and facilitated our sessions over three weeks. And a special thank you to all who participated, giving voice to their aspiration and hearing each others' perspective. The process will now develop from the local community to regional gatherings beginning on 18 October and then to the level of the Diocese itself in December.

The excursion to the Sydney Aquarium on Friday 28th September 2018 took place on a warm Spring day. We took a ferry from Circular Quay to Barangaroo and had morning tea and then walked to the Aquarium at Darling Harbour. The first exhibits in the Aquarium showed displays of plants like coral and various fish including an eel. The main exhibits were reached by walking along a corridor with a curved glass ceiling above where Sting Rays, sharks, turtles, Dugongs and fish could be seen swimming in a tank of water above the ceiling. Next we boarded a rubber dinghy which carried us along a stream where we could see penguins in a glass enclosure. When we had finished viewing the exhibits we went to a canteen where we had lunch. ## Celebrating our 70th Anniversary as a Parish

For nearly 70 years, our Parish has been the owner of a magnificent bell, caste in Dublin. It was initially intended that the bell would hang in our brick bell tower that was designed to be entered from the eastern side of the church. You can see the archway in the brickwork where this tower was originally designed. When our church was built the funds were not there to complete the tower, and so our bell sat on the ground for many, many years. It has quite the history, being stolen at some stage and then being used by St Leo's College. Now, through the architectural genius of Peter Georgiades and the remarkable generosity of the Sullivan Family, our Parish bell will rise from the ground and proudly hang in our Parish garden to be seen always, and heard on special occasions. The design of the construction is in the form of an Arch that mirrors the archways of the French doors outside our History Gallery and sunroom, the arches of the church windows and the arches of our Portico. Construction is well underway and work has begun on creating the foundations for the bell, ahead of our celebration on Sunday 28 October.
