## 1st September - 22nd SUNDAY in ORDINARY TIME

Dear friends,

At a dinner party a rather pretentious woman was seated next to a rabbi. Wishing to impress him, she said, 'One of my ancestors signed the Declaration of Independence.' 'Indeed', replied the rabbi, 'One of mine wrote the ten commandments.'

In this Sunday's gospel from Mark (7:1-8. 14-15, 21-23), Jesus speaks out against the Pharisees for accusing his disciples of not observing the Jewish purity laws. The example used in Mark is the washing of hands to the elbow, turning fingers one way and then the other. Jesus is not against cleanliness. What Jesus is saying to the Pharisees is that this purity law is about acknowledging sin. The outward sign, the washing of hands, should be a reflection of the heart opening itself to God.

While laws are essentially good structures to live by, sometimes laws developed over a long period of time, and can in the present time bear no resemblance or relevance to their original intention.

Initially when Moses handed down the ten commandments, and other basic laws it helped to unite Israel as a nation under God. These laws passed down from generation to generation helped to form the Jewish identity.

Jesus did not want to abolish Jewish laws, but rather to restore their true meaning and purpose. The laws of God and religious practice need to enable us to encounter God and deepen our relationship with Him.


