# 10 November - 32nd Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear friends,

Our Holy Father Pope Francis has just completed a consultation process with members of the Church in Rome. The members included laity, Priests, Bishops, Cardinals and of course the Holy Father. There were 200 delegates gathered to discern the ways in which the Holy Spirit was calling us forward to renew and sustain the Catholic Church into the 21<sup>st</sup> Century. Bishop Anthony Randazzo and Mrs Kelly Paget (Chancellor of the Diocese of Broken Bay) were delegates to the consultation process.

Bishop Anthony in the September issue of the Broken Bay News said: 'As we journey together in faith within our Diocese of Broken Bay, it is important to reflect on the vision and characteristics of a Synodal Church - a Church that walks together, listens and discerns in communion.'

Bishop Randazzo is inviting all communities in the Diocese of Broken Bay to participate in a synodal and discerning way to examine the needs of our parish of Holy Name Wahroonga and other parishes. We will discern how in conversation with one another we can listen and respond to how the Spirit is speaking to us.

I invite each one of you from the parish community to a Parish Consultation Forum on Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> November from 6.00pm -8.30 p.m. to be held in the Sunroom. We will begin with drinks and nibblies to begin the evening, so it is important to register with the Parish Office either by calling 9489 3221 (please leave a message if unattended) OR email your attendance to <a href="https://holpane@bbcatholic.org.au">holyname@bbcatholic.org.au</a>

The input received from the night will be collated and processed into a document from the parishes of this Deanery of the Lower North Shore which will present a particular demographic and respond to emerging issues, so that we can discern how to move forward. The key to this discernment process is to involve all the faithful so that by listening to one another, we may more faithfully reflect our calling to be the Body of Christ.

Bishop Anthony Randazzo concludes his message by saying: 'A Synodal Church is a community that is faithful to Scripture and Tradition and that listens, participates, discerns and includes, and serves together.'
