Dear friends,

This Sunday's gospel from St. Matthew (Mt 18:15-20), calls us to correct our brother or sister when they have done something wrong. Jesus says: 'If your brother or sister does something wrong, go and have it out with them.' We all have a responsibility to care for our neighbour, and like Jesus, it means speaking the truth in love when they have done something wrong.

Of course the person may not see the error of what they have done wrong, and they may not appreciate us telling them so. But so long as the correction is done out of love and concern, rather than out of anger and resentment, then we are well on the way to maturing in our faith and growing closer to God.

We are all human, and sometimes it is hard to forgive or correct someone, but grudges and resentments can be like closing a wound with the infection still inside. The wound must be lanced, opened and cleaned before it can heal. The sacrament of Reconciliation is a time to experience the healing of our wounds through the forgiveness of Jesus our Saviour. During this time of the Lord's grace we are reminded of St. Paul's letter to the Romans today in our second reading: 'Love is the one thing that cannot hurt your neighbour; that is why it is the answer to every one of the commandments. (Rom 13: 10).
