Dear friends,

Last Thursday, 8th August, we celebrated the Feast of our first Saint, St. Mary of the Cross (MacKillop). Mary of the Cross founded the sisters of St Joseph (often known as the 'brown joeys' because of their distinctive brown habit) in 1866 in Penola, South Australia. Although Mary died in 1909, it would take another 100 years for her being made a saint. Mary was canonized by Pope Benedict in 2010 in Rome.

Mary's ministry of education to children in Australia, particularly extended to the outback areas of the Australian bush. This model of religious life, where a few nuns would cater to the needs of an outback community especially those without the presence of a priest to celebrate Mass was quite groundbreaking.

Despite the vast distances between the nun's communities Mary took it upon herself to visit her sisters and offer them her support. There is the story of Mary MacKillop travelling up the river by boat to the orphanage in Kincumber (which the sisters conducted) and bringing sweets and toys for the children. Mary MacKillop never lost sight of her mission: to bring the Kingdom of Heaven to all here on earth.

We honour St. Mary of the Cross for her vision, and the courage which called her and the sisters of St. Joseph, in their work of Catholic education and the foresight in caring for the impoverished outback communities of Australia, always trusting in the providence of God.

This Sunday, we welcome our Year 1 and Year 5 Prouille teachers, students and their families and thank them for hosting this Sunday's 9:30am Mass.

The Assumption of Mary, or simply The Assumption, is the taking up of the body of Virgin Mary to heaven. It signifies the end of her human life on earth.

This event is one of the most important events in Christian community. This day is considered as heavenly birthday of the Virgin Mary.

She who appeared to be a simple, "poor and lowly" young woman from an obscure village accepted the call of God to be Mother of the Saviour: "be it done unto me according to your Word". She is the highest honour of our race, the One whom all generations will call "Blessed" - recognised as Mother of God and Queen of Heaven.




