Dear friends,

In Israel, they have built a bridge across part of the Sea of Galilee which is built of transparent material. The bridge is also built at water level so that pilgrims can experience what it might have been like when Jesus walked on the Sea of Galilee.

In today's gospel Matthew (14: 22-33) has Peter walking to Jesus across the water. Some people think that if you have enough faith, life will be plain sailing. But at some point we all face difficult and trying circumstances in our lives. At those times it is as if the Lord is calling us to walk on water. At the same time, he stretches out his hand and holds us up.

Peter is the model of a very human journey of faith. He seeks, he steps, he fails, he is saved and praises God. The sea is often used as a metaphor for life. Perhaps the Gospel is saying that no matter how dark life might be, and no matter how high the waves, Jesus will be able to lift us up out of our difficulties, if we keep our eyes fixed on him.

Later in the early Church, this scene in the gospel became a metaphor for Peter as Pope, guiding his small boat (the Church), through the difficulties of this world as it is buffeted by terrors and unseen forces trying to bring the Church down.

Christ is always central to calming the waves and steadying the boat. Let us place our trust in his power to save.


