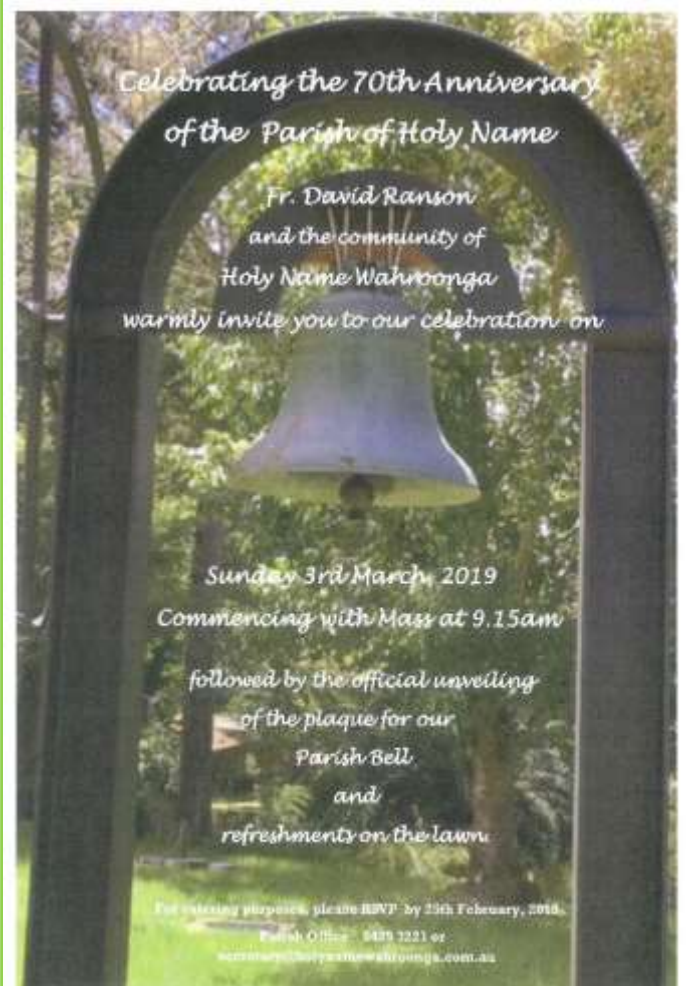

Dear friends,

Through everyone's generosity we are able to continue to improve our parish site and its assets. Recently, we have been able to undertake some renovations in the Priory opening up the space between the kitchen and the lounge room. In the coming weeks we will be able to replace some very old windows in the Priory and attend to the problem of the damp in the basement with the installation of new dehumidifiers. Last week, we were able to replace the decayed guttering on the western side of the church, and in the coming weeks we will attend to the external frames of the high western windows of the church which are in need of repair. Then, soon, I am hoping that we can begin the project of renewing and extending the carpark outside the Portico of the church, made possible because of the great generosity of parishioners at our Grand Trivia Fundraiser last November. The work of maintenance and repair is never completed, but little by little we actually achieve many improvements over the course of the year. Thank you for making this possible so that our parish centre may be as best maintained and attractive as possible.

A special thank you, too, to all those who have generously offered to become a part of our liturgical rosters. Over a dozen people have come forward to contribute in this way which is quite delightful. Our wonderful Chris Goldrick is now coordinating the rosters for these ministries.

This weekend Chris Madden and John Boswell will invite us to consider becoming involved in our St Martin de Porres Guild—our association of generous parishioners who, each week, take Holy Communion to those who are sick in the San Hospital, Neringah Hospice, UPA, Hammond Care in North Turramurra and Wahroonga, Lady Davidson and to those who are housebound. Might you consider joining our great team?

We realise that peoples' circumstances change, so please don't feel that if you make a decision to join one of our ministries now you are locked in for life! Any way you can contribute is mightily appreciated! And a very special thank you to all those who coordinate our ministries on our behalf. They are true gems!
