Please Join us for Mass

Until 1st July, our Sunday Masses we are limited to 50 people, not including the priest and other ministers.

To provide as many people as possible to attend weekly weekend Mass we offer 6 Masses each weekend until the end of June:

Saturday: 5.00pm and 6.30pm

Sunday: 8.00am, 9.30am, 11.00am and 5.30pm

We will continue to make available Our Sunday Mass online.

We invite you to register for one weekend Mass This will then be your allocated Mass each weekend for the time ahead.

Remember: In order to comply with the requirement of no more than 50 people at a religious gathering, we ask that only those who have first registered through the Parish Office attend a Sunday Mass We are also obliged to record the names of those who attend each Mass so that we can assist in the Government's strategy of testing, tracing and isolating.

Mass will also be available Tuesday - Friday at 9.15am

It is not necessary to register for these weekday Masses, but we will need you to sign in with your contact details. People may attend one or more of the weekday Masses.

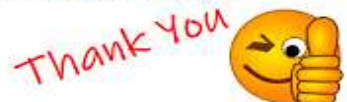

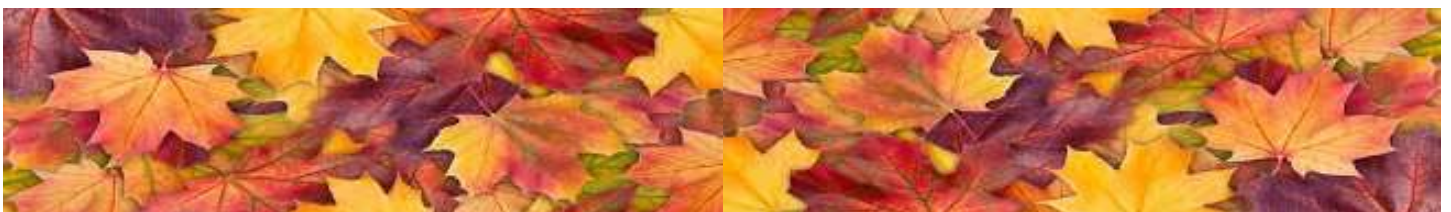

From Fr David

Dear friends,

We continue to adapt to the changing circumstances as responsively and as responsibly as we can. For these next two weekends we will maintain our schedule of 6 Masses with 50 people each. However, from the first weekend of July, all going well, we will be able to revert largely to our ordinary schedule of Masses with the addition of a Sunday 8am Mass. We are so fortunate that our church is of a size that we can accommodate quite a large group of people, albeit respecting the requirement of social distancing. In the coming weeks, too, small groups in our parish will be able to meet again using our Parish Sunroom (limited to 11 persons). We are now hopeful that come August we might largely be back to normal.

We speak of going 'back to normal' but, of course, our world has changed. Therefore, it not about going 'back' but about going forward to something new, informed by the many lessons we have learnt over these months. Some of these are represented in new skills particularly with social media. Others of them are to be found in corrections to patterns of life and practice to which we may have become accustomed but which may not always have been well-founded. The future. Then. presents itself as a real invitation to see our life in a new way.

In these weeks as we begin to 'regroup' as a community, we think of those whose circumstances are such as for them to be still cautious about coming into a confined space. Let us think of personal ways to reach out to them to assure them of their belonging .

Do keep in mind the survey that we have available on our electronic mail out. The outcomes of this will be of great assistance to our Parish Pastoral and Missionary Council as we reflect together on the best way forward.
