Through this week we also think of our students who are undertaking their HSC Examinations which began last Thursday. No doubt it is an anxious time for them and their families. We pray the Lord's gentle presence in their hearts and minds during this significant period.

During this week our amazing arch will arrive from which will hang our Parish Bell! Next Sunday morning we will celebrate this most auspicious development with a Ceremony to commission and bless the Bell, which we will name in honour of St Martin de Porres who has a special place in the devotional life of our parish community. For the ceremony of blessing we will be joined by the choir from Prouille School and the band from St Leos' College, and I express my gratitude to them for their involvement for the occasion.

The Bell will also be dedicated to the memory of John Reginald Sullivan (1928-2010), husband of Moira and father of Catherine whose generosity has made this project possible..

Following the Blessing and Ringing of our Parish Bell we will be treated to a gourmet lunch in the parish gardens! What a wonderful way to celebrate our 70th anniversary as a Parish!! And of course, on the day, too, we will be joined by Prouille Soccer Club which will be celebrating their annual awards.. So there will be much festivity and fun! Do come along! Invite your families and friends and make this a true celebration of our community!

Our celebration next Sunday will be the first of two focussing on our 'new' bell. Once we have ensured that all the engineering of the arch and bell are working according to design, we will hold a second event early next year co-inciding with the 65th anniversary of the opening our church in March. At this event we will hold a special Morning Tea and invite along our local members of parliament and other guests to join us as we unveil a special plaque on the side of the church that will acknowledge all the details of those who have contributed so generously to the construction of the project. There have been many, many people involved from the start of this project, and they have all been brought together under the direction of our architect Peter Georgiades who has dedicated the most remarkable amount of time, energy and expertise to enabling the project to be realised. We thank Peter profoundly for his passion and his love of our community that has underscored his extraordinary generosity of time and competence.

For nearly 70 years, our Parish has been the owner of a magnificent bell, cast in Dublin. It was initially intended that the bell would hang in our brick bell tower that was designed to be entered from the eastern side of the church. You can see the archway in the brickwork where this tower was originally designed. When our church was built the funds were not there to complete the tower, and so our bell sat on the ground for many, many years. It has quite the history, being stolen at some stage and then being used by St Leo's College. Now, through the architectural genius of Peter Georgiades and the remarkable generosity of the Sullivan Family, our Parish bell will rise from the ground and proudly hang in our Parish garden to be seen always, and heard on special occasions. The design of the construction is in the form of an Arch that mirrors the archways of the French doors outside our History Gallery and sunroom, the arches of the church windows and the arches of our Portico. Construction is well underway and work has begun on creating the foundations for the bell, ahead of our celebration on Sunday 28 October.



Prouille Football Club will join us on 28 October with their annual awards and BBQ. There will be Jumping Castles and Face Painting for the children.

The other way by which we will celebrate our 70th Anniversary is by our Parish Grand Trivia night on Saturday 3 November!



Having consulted our Parish Pastoral Council and our Parish Finance Committee, the monies that we raise on this occasion will be at the service of renewing and extending the carpark asphaltting outside the entrance to the church. This will enable more car parking, enhance the entrance to the church and address some of the WHS issues that we currently have on the approach to the church.
