## From Fr David

Dear friends,

Our deep sympathy to Melviin Phan, whose father Manh passed away in Melbourne on 14 August. Sadly, given the current restrictions it was not possible for Melvin to be with his family. We think of him and all those who are separated from their loved ones at this time given the closure of State borders and the inability to travel overseas. Eternal rest grant unto Manh O Lord and let perpetual light shine upon him. May his soul, and the soul of all the faithful departed rest in peace.

At this stage of our navigation of the pandemic I think we are all beginning to experience a sense of loss: the loss of not being able to gather in numbers, the loss of freedom of movement and travel, the loss of stability and certainty. We are beginning to realise that the situation will not change for at least another twelve months, and this places the way in which we live and the way by which we do things under question. How best might we live as fully as we can in the midst of this challenge? Our Parish Pastoral and Missionary Council will be meeting again this coming Tuesday, and this consideration will be uppermost in our attention.

We continue to be vigilant in our gatherings, grateful however, that the situation in NSW remains as contained. Again we need to stress: if you are unwell and have any flu-like symptoms, you must not be present in a public place. It is critically important that you isolate immediately and are tested. However, I also need to emphasise that if you are vulnerable to infection because of age or health, or someone with whom you live is in such a situation, now is not the time to be attending Mass. You should limit your presence in public places.
