From Fr David

Dear friends,

It is only another week and I will begin my period of sabbatical! I leave on 2 July and will be away until 11 September. Much work has been done in the background to put all that needs to be in place whilst I am away, and I am hopeful that there will, in fact, be minimal disruption whilst I am away. Our wonderful Parish Secretary, Jackie, will continue to coordinate the many practical matters that sustain the life of our community, and together we have worked on all the various processes to achieve this whilst I am away. She will be supported by wonderful members of our parish community who, very generously, will be on hand to lend their assistance when required.

As you know the Australian Catholic Bishops have requested from the Holy Father the opportunity to hold a Plenary Council in 2020. The journey to the Plenary was launched on Pentecost Sunday, 20 May. For the time ahead, the task ahead is to enable every community the chance to contribute to a process of listening and discernment. To this end, our own Diocese of Broken Bay has invited every parish to nominate Local Animators to facilitate circles of discussion and discernment about what the Spirit is saying to the Church. I am very happy to share with you that five people have generously agreed to act in this capacity for our own parish: Tom Waugh, Ken Laing, Gemma McDermott, Patrick Kirkwood and Annette Stuart-Robertson. Our Animators will attend a special training day in early August and then think through together, under the chairmanship of Tom Waugh, what opportunities may be best for our own parish context. Jessica Russell, our Prouille REC will be the Animator for Prouille and Ralph Kershler has been chosen as the Animator for St Leo's College. Tom will be in touch with me whilst I am away if it is judged prudential to commence the process of conversation in our Parish before mid-September. Otherwise, the second half of September and October will present us with the opportunity to enter the Plenary Process prior to Diocesan gatherings with Bishop Peter towards the end of the year. Let us pray that the process will be one of true renewal for our Church!

Obviously, I have pared back a number of our normal activities during the period of my absence so that the least burden may be experienced by others. To this end, for example:

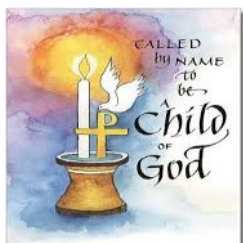
The Blessed Sacrament will not be placed in the Aquinas Chapel on a Tuesday;

Mission Australia Trip Report by James Toomey

Jo and I arrived in Alice Springs on Sunday 3 June and met up with the remainder of the team of walkers and our guides on 4 June. I also met with the Mayor of Alice Springs to discuss homelessness and was interviewed on ABC Alice Springs on the subject of homelessness in the Northern Territory and why we were undertaking the trek. Put simply Mission Australia is seeking to open a new homeless outreach service in the NT based on the Missionbeat service in inner Sydney, Perth, Hobart and Brisbane. The reason we are seeking to do this is because (as reinforced by the latest homelessness stats released by the ABS) homelessness, particularly rough-sleeping and severe overcrowding is a bigger problem in the NT than in any other part of Australia.

Over four days and four nights a group of sponsored walkers from across Australia walked four different sections of the Larapinta Trail in the MacDonnell Ranges west of Alice Springs. In total we trekked more than 60km and slept each night in swags around a campfire. Night time temperatures were quite low, but because it was very still we were spared from wind-chill. The most memorable section was the day we climbed Mt Sonder (1380m) in the dark. We did this in order to reach the summit before sunrise just after 7am, to do so we got up at 1am and started walking at 2.30am.

The whole experience was memorable and left us all with a considerable sense of achievement, not least because together we have raised \$70,000 so far towards our target of \$150,000 which will be sufficient to commence the new service.

Jo and I are very grateful to the Holy Name parishioners and their generous donations, it is wonderful to be part of such a kind community. This photo is of Jo and I on the summit, and a photo of Mt Sonder itself.

Spirit of St Lucy's

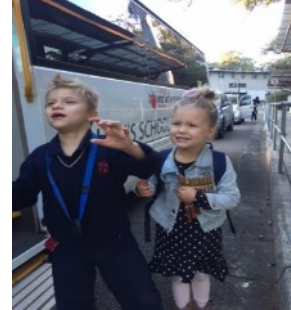
Siblings Day:

The Parish Co-ordinator works as part of a team consisting of the Parish Priest, Assistant Priests, pastoral and other workers. The Parish Co-ordinator is accountable to the Parish Priest. The role involves the provision of a range of duties to ensure the smooth and effective operation of the parish office.

Oversee the upkeep and maintenance of parish property and ensure the functionality of meeting rooms etc;

Ensuring Parish workers have been trained in and the Parish complies with the Diocesan policies including Work Health and Safety.
