Dear Parishioners of Holy Name,

Celebrating Christ the King

Today, as we commemorate the Solemnity of Christ the King, we're reminded of the majesty and authority of Jesus Christ - our Saviour, life, and hope. Established by Pope Pius XI in 1925, this feast counters the tide of secularism and atheistic ideologies, affirming Christ's sovereign rule over all aspects of our lives. As we conclude the liturgical year, we crown it with the recognition of Jesus as the King of the Universe.

In today's homily, we reflect on how the kingship of Christ isn't about political dominance but about a spiritual reign within our hearts. We are called to prioritize Jesus in everything we do, think, and say. This counters the modern tendency to sideline faith in favour of secular pursuits, a trend seen in the overemphasis on scientific understanding at the expense of spiritual wisdom.

As faithful followers of Jesus, we're encouraged to display our faith openly and to embody Christ's teachings in our daily lives. This includes acts of kindness, love, and particularly, service to those in need.

We thank the parish volunteers involved in the Procession, Morning Tea, and Pop-Up Choir at the 9:30am Mass for helping us mark the day with extra solemnity!

St Vincent de Paul Christmas Hamper Appeal

In line with today's Gospel, where Jesus identifies Himself with the hungry, the thirsty, the stranger, and the imprisoned, our *St. Vincent de Paul Christmas Hamper Appeal* is a practical way to serve Christ by serving others. By contributing to this cause, we are actively participating in building God's kingdom through care for the poor and vulnerable. Let's continue to support this initiative, as these small acts of kindness are indeed significant in the eyes of God.

Our Parish St Vincent de Paul Conference will again be asking parishioners to prepare Christmas Hampers for local families and individuals who have received help from Vinnies this year. In addition we will providing hampers to families in need living in the Whalan and Emerton areas of western Sydney and also a local Women's shelter. The appeal will be launched at the Vigil and Sunday Masses this weekend 25 and 26 November. Hampers will need to be back at Holy Name before 9.30am Mass on Sunday 10 December. Volunteer drivers to deliver hampers to the Holy Family Centre at Emerton on 8 and 10 December are also needed.
