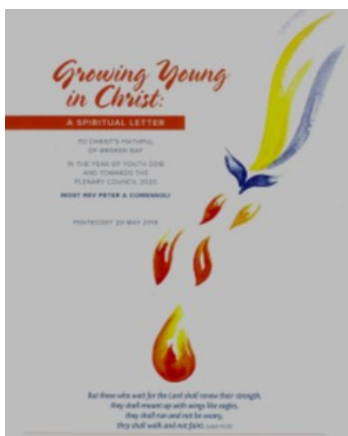

Australian Plenary Council 2020 "Listen to what the Spirit is Saying"



Pope Francis has approved the Australian Bishops' request to hold a Plenary Council in Australia in 2020 and 2021. It is a significant moment for the Church in Australia to make decisions about the future. To prepare the agenda for the Plenary Council, all of God's people are invited to reflect on the question: "What do you think God is asking of us in Australia at this time?"

This Thursday, 31 May, we remember Our Lady Star of the Sea, Patroness of the Diocese of Broken Bay

The Patroness of our Diocese, Mary Star of the Sea received its official decree from the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments in May 2008.

Star of the Sea is an ancient title for the Mother of Jesus Christ, and comes down to us from the Latin Stella Maris.



Under this title Mary intercedes as both guide and protector for all those who travel or seek their livelihoods on or by the sea.

As a faith community whose borders skirt both the Pacific Ocean and the Brisbane Waters, Mary is our guiding star and the model of discipleship as mother of the Church.

The Feast Day of Mary Star of the Sea is celebrated on 31 May.

"Mary, Star of the Sea, must be followed in faith and morals lest we capsize amidst the storm-tossed waves of the sea. She will illumine us to believe in Christ, born of her for the salvation of the world". (Paschasius Radbertus d.865)

A Request from James and Jo Toomey

In June, Jo and I will be trekking 60km of the Larapinta Trail near Alice Springs to raise funds to launch a new urgently needed Mission Australia service in the Northern Territory called Missionbeat.

Missionbeat NT will be a life-saving mobile outreach and support service for young people experiencing homelessness or in need of assistance. You may be aware that Australia's Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people endure disproportionate levels of homelessness and disadvantage, and I believe Missionbeat NT has an important role to play in addressing these issues. You may not be aware that the NT has the highest rate of homelessness in Australia.

As the CEO of Mission Australia, I've seen firsthand the impact Missionbeat has already made in Sydney, Brisbane, Perth and Tasmania, and I know its expansion to the NT will make a significant positive impact. Missionbeat staff aim to meet people's immediate needs, providing food, clothing, medical care and links to safe accommodation where possible. They also work in close collaboration with other organisations to help break the cycle of homelessness for individuals and families.

That's why I'm taking on this challenge – alongside my wife Jo and a number of other enthusiastic Mission Australia supporters – and why I'm asking for your help. I would be so grateful if you could support me and Jo with a donation. Every dollar you give will go directly towards launching Missionbeat in the NT as Jo and I have already covered the expenses associated with the trip. Your donation will be an investment into the lives and futures of vulnerable young Australians in desperate need.
