29th June 2025 — Sts PETER and PAUL

Dear friends,

Today we celebrate the martyrdom of Sts. Peter and Paul. This year of 2025 has been a year which honoured the life of Pope Francis, while electing to the papacy the first American as pope: Pope Leo XIV: both leaders reflecting the different cultural and unique perspectives they have brought to the papacy. They, like their predecessor St. Peter, remain faithful to the teaching of Jesus and the desire to strengthen the bonds of communion between the people and their pastors.

Sts. Peter and Paul were also very different in personality and temperament. Peter matured as leader in courage and wisdom as its founding apostle, Paul also called to be an apostle through his conversion on the road to Damascus, preached and wrote his letters to the early church communities uniting them in love for one another through the transforming power of the Holy Spirit.

While the New Testament does not tell us how these great apostles died, tradition says that both men were martyred in Rome around the same time. It is testimony to their faith that they died for their Saviour Jesus Christ.

The challenge for us today on this feast commemorating their life and work, is to imitate their faith by living out the message entrusted to them by Jesus himself. Jesus calls us today, as he called them, to draw others toward him by our lives of sacrifice and service.

We pray for Pope Leo XIV as he begins his work of caring for the flock entrusted to him by Christ.

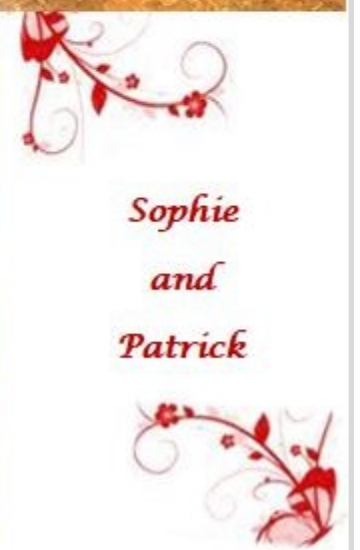

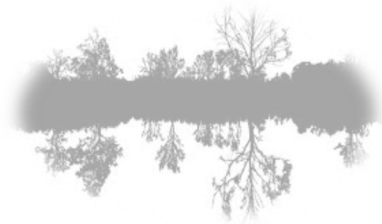

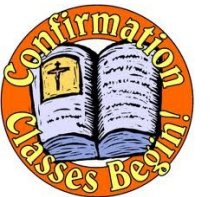

The First Collection taken up at Weekend Masses

The First Collection is for the upkeep of the priests. The monies collected go to a central fund in the Diocese of Broken Bay to ensure equity for all priests working in the Diocese and for retired priests of the Diocese. The fund provides priests a stipend each fortnight, a place to live, and their household expenses.

The Second Collection taken up at Weekend Masses

The Second Collection is for the Parish. These donations provide for support of ministries exercised for the parish and for the maintenance of the parish buildings, including the costs of electricity, insurance and for the costs of the administration of the parish (including printing—we desperately need a new photocopier!) The income of this collection also pays for the phone and car expenses of the Parish Priest, as well as his superannuation.
