### Food Pantry Christmas Items


For Christmas, the Dish will have a Christmas meal and everyone will go home with a few treats. A few ideas would be mince tarts, small pudding or biscuits.

The Advent Wreath is one of the principal symbols in our church in our Liturgy over the next four weeks of waiting and preparation for Christmas. Today, we bless the wreath and light the first candle. Before we do so, let us pause and pray together with a longing and waiting for the coming of the Lord.



### We pray together:

God of grace and promise, at the beginning of the Advent season, we gather as a community to prepare for the coming of Jesus.

We ask you now to bless our Advent Wreath and all who gather round it. May it remind us of the first coming of Jesus in the Incarnation, of His continued coming in our hearts and our world today, and of His future coming in glory.

The wreath is now blessed with holy water.

**Preparing for Christmas** 


#### Dear friends

Each week during Advent we light a candle on a beautiful Advent Wreath prepared for us by Jane Geier, The first candle we light is for Hope. And do we not start this new year with such ardent hope—hope for release from the burden of the pandemic, hope for a return to normalcy even if informed by all the lessons we have learnt this past year, hope that this new year will be an easier one than the last? We gather in hope.

A very special thanks to Paul Sutherland for our great Advent banners and to Mary and Anthony Weaver for another great Christmas tree!

Next weekend we will publish the arrangements we will put in place for our Christmas celebrations. Clearly with COVID restrictions we will need to celebrate Christmas in a very different way than we do ordinarily. We are thinking how can we do this in a way that enables maximum participation, beautiful liturgy and compliance with COVID requirements.

Please do join us at the Parish Luncheon and Fr Joey's farewell on the 6 December. It will be a wonderful way to farewell Fr Joey as well as to come together to celebrate our parish community, particularly after such a difficult year.



Currently, our learning within each class is focused on the Season of Advent. This learning enables the children to experience lots of different traditions that take place within Advent, such as the Advent wreath, the Advent calendar and associated songs and stories.
