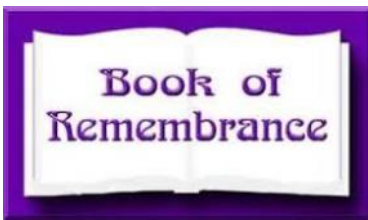

November Mass Counts At the request of the Diocese of Broken Bay, we are conducting November Mass Counts at each of the weekend Masses during November.
