### 3 September 2023 - 22nd SUNDAY in ORDINARY TIME

Dear friends,

Some years ago Bishop Michael Putney, the Catholic Bishop of Townsville diocese, was diagnosed with terminal cancer at the age of 67. People began to ask of his illness: "Why him?" to which Bishop Michael replied: "Why not me?" Despite his suffering over the next year with chemotherapy treatments, he continued to show great pastoral leadership and became an inspiring witness for many.

In today's gospel from Matthew (Mt 16: 21-27), which follows on from last week's gospel when Peter revealed that Jesus was the Son of God. Jesus calls on Peter to be the 'rock' on which he would build his Church. Today, that same Peter becomes a 'stumbling block' to the faith of others. Peter is not pleased with the revelation that the Christ should suffer and die

No one wants to see anyone suffer. The perennial question for Christians is: If God is good, why is there suffering in our world? St. Augustine grappled with this question by asking: If God is good why does evil exist? But, if God does not exist, why is there good?

Suffering is part of being human. It is not a question which admits of an easy answer, but as Jesus says to Peter: "...anyone who loses his life will save it." It is only by entering into the mystery of suffering that we begin to understand and overcome its fears about its grip on our lives. Eventually, Peter will lose his life, by becoming the shepherd, the 'rock', who lays down his life for his sheep, following in the footsteps of Jesus.
