3rd December 2023 - FIRST SUNDAY of ADVENT

Dear friends,

This Sunday we celebrate the First Sunday of Advent known as the beginning of the Church's 'New Year.' In the secular world the beginning of the New Year is marked by the 1st of January by partying and celebration as we begin the new calendar year.

However, the Church invites us to begin the New Year this Sunday by focusing on the spiritual meaning of our lives with the words from the gospel of Mark saying: 'Be on your guard, stay awake, because you never know when the time will come.' (Mk 13:33).

The spiritual writer Fr. John Main OSB, compares this 'spiritual awakening' to the state of a dream where we think 'our dream' is real, and we think it is actually happening to us, until we wake up to the fact that it is only our time of sleep and we are being influenced by our subconscious.

Our consciousness is our time of 'wakefulness' where what is happening to us is 'real.' We are being asked to respond with all our being to the call to love our sisters and brothers as we prepare for the return of the Lord.

Advent is our time to be alive with the love of Christ today and every day until he comes again. Now, is our opportunity to grow closer to Christ and one another.

St. Paul in his letter to the Corinthians this week says:

'I never stop thanking God for all the graces you have received through Jesus Christ.' Those graces are our opportunity to turn away from the negative and superficial events of life to the love of God which gives meaning and purpose to our daily living.

Let us give thanks for all the graces we receive each day in the form of our love from our sisters and brothers, and let us be truly awake as we await the Lord's return.


