Dear friends,

This week we have all marvelled at the athletic prowess of the competitors in the Olympic Games being held in Paris. Competition by many nations highlights the good will and the sheer hard work and effort that provides such results.

The Olympic Games remind me of the words of St. Paul to the Corinthians:

'Do you not know that all the runners in the stadium all run in the race, but only one wins the prize? Run so as to win. Every athlete exercises discipline in every way. They do it to win a perishable crown, but we an imperishable one. Thus I do not run aimlessly. No I drive my body to train it, for fear that after having preached to others, I myself should be disqualified.' (Cor 9:24-27). The city of Corinth held the Isthmain games every two years. The winners were given honorific crowns. Paul using this secular example is able to adapt it to the Christian life.

In the gospel of John today (Jn 6: 24-35) the multitude of people whom Jesus fed in last week's gospel, are pursuing Jesus for more bread. Jesus, reminds them that the bread with which he fed them is perishable food. Like the athlete they need to refine their search and aim higher for the bread that lasts forever.

Jesus offers himself as the Bread of Life, so that as we are spiritually nourished by him. As the nations gather as one under the flag of goodwill and freedom, so we, the Christian family gather to encourage and support one another on our journey through and in Christ our Saviour, who is the source and fulfillment of our journey.

Second Reading: Eph 4:17, 20-24: Put on the new person that has been created in God's image. Alleluia, alleluia!


No one lives on bread alone, but on every word that comes from the mouth of


Parish Family Mass Dates—2024
