In the coming weeks, too, small groups in our parish will be able to meet again using our Parish Sunroom (limited to 11 persons). We are now hopeful that come August we might largely be back to normal.

From Fr David

Dear friends,

Our children and their families have come to the end of a very challenging Term 2. They have now commenced a two week holiday in the hope that Term 3 will bring things back to a greater degree of normality and regularity. We thank the teachers and staff of our own Prouille school for the generous way they have accompanied and supported our students and their families through this time.

On the last day of the term, I gathered with the staff at Prouille as we joined Bishop Anthony and our new Interim Director for Schools, Mr Danny Casey online for a morning of reflection about the future. In fact, the online forum brought together all 44 schools across our Diocese in conversation about the direction forward. A new plan, "Catholic Schools Towards 2025" was introduced. Its vision is clear: "Authentic, professional Catholic education, delivered with care and compassion" as is its purpose: "Inspiring hearts and minds to know Christ, to love learning, to use their talents to be the very best they can." Underscoring this Vision and Purpose are the Values that have been determined by Bishop Anthony: Faith, Joy, Witness, Compassion and Courage. The two strategic themes and priorities of the Plan are "Evangelisation and Catechesis" and "Student Achievement" supported by the Strategic Enablers and Priorities of Governance, Capability and Enablement of our People, Financial Viability and Infrastructure and Facilities.

Bishop Anthony spoke of the importance of our sense of unity going forward together in response to all the many social and financial challenges facing us. Together we need to place our school system on a mission critical basis, welcoming of all and unapologetic for the Tradition in which we exist to form our young people in their discipleship of Christ.

Catholic Education this year celebrates 200 years of service in Australia. May these next five years of mission bring new imagination and vitality into our endeavour!

Celebrating NAIDOC Week

Whilst new dates were announced recently for national celebrations to take place in November, the official organisational body also acknowledged that plans may have already been put in place by various communities and organisations to celebrate NAIDOC Week at its usual time of year: which is exactly what St Lucy's did last week!

The theme for this year's NAIDOC Week is 'Always Was, Always Will Be' and our students explored this so as to better know and understand the richness of our Indigenous people and their culture. During class sessions throughout the week, students were provided with learning tasks to engage with such as Dreamtime stories, cooking bush damper, the symbolism of the Aboriginal flag and the Torres Strait Islander flag, facts about Australia's indigenous history, as well as enjoying some fun and interactive experiences presented by our Creative Artists during their timetabled sessions. A whole class liturgy was facilitated by teachers with their students on Friday, to coincide with our last day mufti day.
