
Men's Rosary & Bible Study: The men of HNW meet every fortnight on a Tuesday night to pray the rosary and read the Gospel. All men welcome.

Easter Offerings:



Novena of the Divine Mercy - Available in the Church

NOVENA OF THE DIVINE MERCY

given to Saint Maria Faustina Kowalska

Taken from her Diary 'Divine Mercy in My Soul'
(Diary reference 1209 to 1229)

THE DIVINE MERCY CHAPLET

given by Our Lord to Saint Maria Faustina Kowalska



The Chaplet can be said at any time but *The Lord* specifically asked that it be recited as a Novena on the nine days before the Divine Mercy Sunday, that is commencing Good Friday.

Jesus promised "By this Novena of Chaplets I will grant every possible grace to souls. This prayer will serve to appease my wrath."

We can pray this Novena for our own personal intentions or we can offer it for the daily intentions dictated by Our Lord to Saint Faustina (see the reverse side of the leaflet)

In 1937 *Jesus* recommended with particular emphasis the veneration of the hour of his death......"At *3:00pm* implore my mercy especially for sinners and if only for a brief moment, immerse yourself in my Passion, particularly in my abandonment at the moment of agony. This is the hour of Great Mercy for the whole world."

Divine Mercy Sunday - 7 April, 2024

Jesus said to Saint Faustina: "I desire that the First Sunday after Easter to be the Feast of Mercy. I want the image to be solemnly blessed on that Sunday".

"On this day the very depths of My Tender Mercy are open....The Soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment".

Saint Faustina was born Helena Kowalska in 1905 in Poland as the third of 10 children in a very poor family. At the age of 20 she entered the Congregation of the Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy. Her life as a religious was marked the stigma of suffering but also with extraordinary mystical graces. She died in 1938 at the age of 33. She was canonised in April 2000 by Pope John Paul II.

The following are excerpts from her diary Divine Mercy In My Soul.


In 1935 *Jesus* appeared to her in her cell. Her Soul was overwhelmed with fear, but also with great joy. One hand was raised in blessing the other touched his garment at the chest from whence came two large rays, one red and one pale.

Jesus said to Saint Faustina: "Paint an image according to the pattern you see, with the signature: Jesus I trust in you. I promise the soul that will venerate this image will not perish. I desire to grant unimaginable graces to those souls that trust in my Mercy."

Jesus said to her: "Say unceasingly the chaplet I have taught you. Whoever will recite it will receive great mercy at the hour of death."

The Chaplet is said on ordinary rosary beads. The leaflet explains the prayers to be said on the Our Father beads and the Hail Mary beads.

Quote for the Week - Divine Mercy Sunday, Second Sunday of Easter 7th April, 2024

"My daughter, have fear of nothing; I am always with you. All your adversaries will harm you only to the degree that I permit them to do so. You are my dwelling place and my constant repose. For your sake I will withhold the hand which punishes; for your sake I bless the earth.'" (No. 431)

"All grace flows from mercy, and 'the last hour' abounds with mercy for us. Let no one doubt concerning the goodness of God; even if a person's sins were as dark as night, God's mercy is stronger than our misery. One thing alone is necessary; that the sinner set ajar the door of his heart, be it ever so little, to let in a ray of God's merciful grace, and then God will do the rest." (No. 1507)

"When I see that a burden is beyond my strength, I do not consider or analyse it or probe into it, but I run like a child to the Heart of Jesus and say only one word to Him: "You can do all things." And then I keep silent, because I know that Jesus Himself will intervene in the matter, and as for me, instead of tormenting myself, I use that time to love Him." (No. 1033)
