Founded in Germany in 1947, ACN today is the only international Catholic charity dedicated to the support of oppressed and persecuted Christians. ACN supports about 5000 projects each year where the Catholic community is unable to sustain itself. Since 2011 ACN has been a Pontifical Foundation. The charity has been operating in Australia for over 50 years, it currently has 20,000 active donors who annually raise around \$4 million for the suffering Church. Some of its works include the formation of seminarians, existence help for religious, Mass offerings for poor priests, construction and reconstruction of churches and transport for pastoral care.

Aid to the Church in Need is not a humanitarian or a mission agency; it is a spiritual and pastoral charity which supports Catholics and Catholic communities in those places where they are at grave risk due to persecution, oppression or poverty.
