Social Justice

Is the time ripe for a new wave of scapegoating?

Today religious and racial groups are victims. The term 'scapegoat' actually has its origin in the Old Testament. God instructed Moses and Aaron to sacrifice two goats every year. The first goat was to be killed and its blood sprinkled upon the Ark of the Covenant. The High Priest was then to lay his hands upon the head of the second goat and confess the sins of the people. This lucky second goat was not to be killed but released into the wilderness together with its burden of sin. This is why it came to be known as a scapegoat.

In modern society, scapegoating "works": the community or media concentrates violence on a small, powerless set of victims.
