Return and Earn

You probably know about the 10 cent cash refund on some recyclable containers. As a way of raising money for the Parish a parishioner is setting up a location on the north-east side of the church for us to drop off containers when we come to Mass. He will then take them to the re-cycling depot and any money earned will go into the Parish Account.

Most containers between 150ml and 3L that are made of PET/HDPE, Aluminium/ Steel, Glass and Liquid paperboard are eligible for return. Wine and cordial bottles and non-beverage containers such as shampoo or detergent bottles cannot be returned. See flyer on notice board.

Containers need to be marked with the 10c refund logo on the label; empty of liquid; and not crushed or broken.

There are ten suitable container hanging outside the main door of the church. This represents a potential \$1 donation tot the parish.
