#### **Social Justice**

Coercive control is a key part of domestic violence. So why isn't it a crime across Australia?

The recent killing of Hannah Clarke and her three children by her estranged husband has raised national attention to the types of behaviour that might lead to such a horrific crime.

Coercive control is a collection of behaviours designed to strip someone of their sense of autonomy and self-worth. Examples of these behaviours include removing male contacts from a partner's social media, dictating where and when their partner sleeps and eats, threats of self-harm if the relationship ends, and physical violence. Perpetrators are nearly always male and come from all works of life and social demographics.
