Reflection

Parables of Mercy. The parables in today's Gospel all speak of the mercy of God. When we stray from the right path, God comes looking for us, not to condemn us but to offer us forgiveness. If we are contrite, God will lift us up and carry us back to the community, as a shepherd carries a stray sheep back to the flock. What great rejoicing there will be in our reunion with God and with the community.

MacKillop College are selling books to help raise funds for the Indigenous Literacy Foundation. The books are from 50c each and are suitable for preschoolers to adults. The books sale is in the MacKillop library and open during school hours.

The Literacy foundation uses the money to publish books in language in remote communities and to run writing workshops. Only 35% of Indigenous students in Northern Territory communities can read in year 5 and 95% of non-Indigenous students in major cities can read in year 5 we need to close the gap.
